NOTICE OF MOTION

TAKE NOTICE that an application will be made on behalf of the Petitioners in these proceedings (collectively, the "Medican Group" or the "Applicants") before the Honourable Justice K.M. Horner, in Chambers, at the Calgary Courts Centre, 601 - 5th Street SW, in the City of Calgary, Province of Alberta on Thursday, the 30th day of September, 2010 at 1:00 o'clock in the afternoon or so soon thereafter as counsel may be heard, for the following relief:

- 1. Declaring service of notice of this application and the supporting materials to be good and sufficient, and abridging the time therefor, if necessary.
- 2. An Order, substantially in the form of the Order attached hereto as Schedule "A":

- (a) approving the financing arrangement between Homes by Kingsland Ltd. ("Kingsland") and 1554670 Alberta Ltd. ("1554670") outlined in the 1554670 Financing Agreement, as defined in the Affidavit of Tyrone Schneider, sworn September 27, 2010 (the "Schneider Affidavit"), with respect to Kingsland and the Edgewood Brooks Project, as defined in the Schneider Affidavit;
- (b) authorizing the Medican Group to perform all of its obligations under the 1554670 Financing Agreement with respect to the Edgewood Brooks Project;
- (c) granting the 1554670 Charge, as defined in the Schneider Affidavit, over the Edgewood Brooks Project, and ranking in priority to the DIP Lender's Charge, the Administration Charge and the Directors' Charge, as defined in the Initial Order (the "Initial Order") granted in these proceedings on May 26, 2010 (the "CCAA Charges"); and
- (d) authorizing the use of the first advance made under the 1554670 Financing Agreement to pay out existing creditors of the Edgewood Brooks Project.
- 3. Orders, substantially in the form attached hereto as Schedules "B" and "C", seeking bid procedures in respect of:
 - (a) Phases 2 & 3 of the Riverstone Project, as defined in the Schneider Affidavit; and
 - (b) the Sonata Ridge Project, as defined in the Schneider Affidavit,

by which the Medican Group can solicit offers to purchase those properties (the "Bid Procedure Orders").

- 4. An Order, substantially in the form of Order attached hereto as Schedule "D", approving the credit bid and the sale and transfer of Phases 2 & 3 of the Axxess Sylvan Lake Project, as defined in the Schneider Affidavit, to Monarch Land Ltd. ("Monarch").
- 5. An Order, substantially in the form of the Order attached hereto as Schedule "E", approving the sale of commercial property (the "7th Street Property") held by R7 Investments

- Ltd. ("R7") to Memory Lane Computer Training Inc. (formerly 937335 Alberta Ltd.), doing business as Cypress College ("Cypress College").
- 6. An Order, substantially in the form of Order attached hereto as Schedule "F", approving the sale of a condominium unit by R7 to Gerald and Marjory Kornelson.
- 7. An Order, substantially in the form attached hereto as Schedule "G", for the following relief:
 - (a) granting an extension to the Stay Period granted in these proceedings under the provisions of the *Companies' Creditors Arrangement Act*, R.S.C. 1985, c. C-36, as amended ("CCAA") from the current expiry date of September 30, 2010 to December 2, 2010;
 - (b) allowing the late claim of Condominium Corporation Plan No. 9812578 to be filed in these proceedings, notwithstanding that the claim was filed after the Claims Bar Date, as defined in the Claims Procedure Order granted in these proceedings on June 11, 2010;
 - (c) approving an extension to the DIP arrangement with Paragon Capital Corporation Ltd.; and
 - (d) increasing the Administration Charge by \$750,000.
- 8. Such further and other relief as counsel may advise and this Honourable Court deems just.

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that the grounds for this application are as follows:

The Edgewood Brooks Project

- 1. The Edgewood Brooks Project is a Development Project that comprises a two phase town house development project located in Brooks, Alberta.
- 2. The Medican Group has received an offer to finance the completion of the Edgewood Brooks Project by making available up to \$633,000 to complete the Project. The first advance of

this facility would be used to pay \$196,000 in favour of all the existing creditors of the Edgewood Brooks Project who are critical to the completion of the Project.

- 3. The terms of the proposed financing is, in the view of the Medican Group and its advisors, fair, reasonable, and necessary for the Medican Group to maximize value for its stakeholders.
- 4. The proposed financing is necessary to complete the Edgewood Brooks Project, and is consistent with the Medican Group's efforts to work with the Monitor, and its creditors, to finance and complete uncompleted development projects where it is anticipated there is recoverable value for the Medican Group's stakeholders in this case approximately \$65,000.
- 5. The Monitor approves the proposed financing and the 1554670 Charge Order, and supports this application.
- 6. The beneficiaries of the CCAA Charges all consent to the relief sought under the 1554670 Charge Order, as do the secured lenders to Edgewood Brooks Project.

The Bid Procedure Orders

- 7. The Medican Group, in consultation with the Monitor, has determined that some uncompleted development projects will not lead to a higher recoverable value for the stakeholders upon completion than they would though a sales process. In particular, the Medican Group and the Monitor have determined that Phases 2 & 3 of the Riverstone Project and the Sonata Ridge Project should be sold through an orderly bid process.
- 8. The Medican Group, with the assistance of the Monitor, has developed a sales procedure whereby certain uncompleted development projects will be offered for sale through a bid process overseen by the Monitor.
- 9. The Bid Procedure Orders contemplate a request for bids, negotiations with certain potential and qualified bidders, and the selection of a successful bidder with the consultation and approval of the Monitor.

- 10. The terms of the Bid Procedure Orders are, in the view of the Medican Group and its advisors, fair, reasonable, and necessary for the Medican Group to maximize value for its stakeholders.
- 11. The Monitor approves the Bid Procedure Orders and supports this application.

The Axxess Sylvan Lake Transfer/Sale

- 12. The Medican Group, with the assistance of the monitor, implemented a sales procedure with respect to Phases 2 & 3 of the Axxess Sylvan Lake Project. The sales procedure did not result in any bids.
- 13. Monarch has agreed to acquire the Phases 2 & 3 of the Axxess Sylvan Lake Project on the following terms and conditions:
 - (a) the outstanding principal owing by the Medican Group to Monarch will be reduced by the appraised value, namely the sum of \$690,000;
 - (b) Monarch will pay to Fraser Milner Casgrain LLP the sum of \$34,500 to hold as security for the CCAA Charges; and
 - (c) the Medican Group will transfer Phases 2 & 3 of the Axxess Sylvan Lake Project to Monarch, free and clear of all interests of the Medican Group and those claiming by or through the Medican Group.
- 14. The Monitor approves of this sale and supports this application.

The R7 – 7th Street Property Sale

15. On September 13, 2010, after this Honourable Court heard from counsel that George Schow Professional Corporation ("Schow") was prepared to bid on the 7th Street Property as an alternative to advancing any claim in respect of his potential leasehold interest in the property, the Court directed that the Medican Group and the Monitor conduct a closed bid tender process with respect to the 7th Street Property. Both Schow and Cypress College submitted sealed bids to the Monitor. The bid from Cypress College was the superior bid. The sale is expected to see the

mortgagee of the 7th Street Property paid out in full with some equity available to the Medican Group's stakeholders.

16. The Monitor approves of this sale and supports this application.

The R7 - Kornelson Sale

- 17. The Medican Group received an increased offer to purchase a condominium unit located in Medicine Hat, Alberta held by R7 (the "River Ridge Property") from Gerald and Marjory Kornelson for the sum of \$297,000 (the "River Ridge Offer"). The River Ridge Offer is the result of a listing process, is comparable to the appraised value for the River Ridge Property, and is the result of a negotiated sale price with an arm's-length party. The sale will see the mortgagee of the property paid out in full with some equity available to the Medican Group stakeholders. Such equity would be held in trust with counsel to the Medican Group pending an agreement with applicable secured parties or further order of this Honourable Court.
- 18. The Monitor approves of this sale and supports this application.

Late Claim

- 19. Condominium Corporation Plan No. 9812528 filed a proof of claim (the "Claim") with the Monitor and the Medican Group on September 14, 2010, after the July 30, 2010 Claims Bar Date, as defined in the Claims Procedure Order, granted June 11, 2010.
- 20. It appears to the Medican Group that the late filing was a result of inadvertence, not for any improper purpose, and has no effect on the current status of these restructuring proceedings. Neither the Medican Group nor the Monitor has any objection to the Claim being filed late.

The Stay Extension

- 21. Since the extension granted by this Honourable Court on August 12, 2010, the Medican Group has worked diligently on all aspects of this restructuring, including obtaining court approval:
 - (a) of sales (and a vesting order) with respect to: (i) the Sylvan Lake Dipert Lands; and (ii) the Saamis Drive Property;

- (b) to commence (and, with the assistance of the Monitor, has commenced) a sales process with respect to Phases 4, 5, 6 & 7 of the Kaleido Project in Westbank, British Columbia;
- (c) of the transaction in respect of the Cimarron Project; and
- (d) of financing from: (i) TEV for the completion of the Michener Project in Red Deer, Alberta; and (ii) Macdonald Terwillegar Properties Ltd. for the completion the marketing of Phase 1 of the Terwillegar Project in Edmonton, Alberta.
- 22. An extension of the Stay Period to December 2, 2010 is necessary to continue the restructuring of the Medican Group and to allow the Medican Group to continue to stabilize its operations, communicate with its stakeholders, prioritize its projects, and develop a viable plan to enable the Medican Group to emerge from these proceedings for the benefit of all stakeholders.
- 23. An extension of the DIP financing arrangement to December 31, 2010 with a 2% extension fee payable upon maturity and an expansion of the Administration Charge by \$750,000 are also necessary to address the Medican Group's current liquidity challenge and to facilitate a successful restructuring.
- 24. The Medican Group continues to work closely with the Monitor and all of the Medican Group's stakeholders in all respects and the Monitor supports the proposed relief and stay extension.
- 25. The Medican Group is working in good faith and with due diligence in these proceedings and believe it is within the best interests of the Medican Group and all stakeholders to continue in these proceedings as outlined above.

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that the Applicants will rely upon the Affidavit of Tyrone Schneider, dated September 27th, 2010, filed; the Sixth Report of the Monitor, dated September 27th, 2010 filed; the pleadings and other materials filed herein; the provisions of the

Companies' Creditors Arrangement Act (Canada) and the Alberta Rules of Court; and such further and other material as counsel may advise and this Honourable Court may permit.

ORDER (1554670 Charge – Edgewood Brooks Project)

UPON the application of the Petitioners in these proceedings (collectively, the "**Medican Group**"); **AND UPON** having read the Notice of Motion of the Petitioners, dated September 27, 2010, the Affidavit of Tyrone Schneider, dated September 27, 2010 (the "**Schneider Affidavit**"), the Sixth Report of the Monitor, dated September 27, 2010, the Affidavit of Ronica Cameron,

dated September _____, 2010 (the "Service Affidavit"), and such other material in the pleadings and proceedings as deemed necessary; AND UPON hearing counsel for the Medican Group, counsel for the proposed financier, 1554670 Alberta Ltd. ("1554670"), counsel for the Monitor, and other interested parties; AND UPON NOTING that the holders of the DIP Lender's Charge, the Administration Charge, and the Directors' Charge all consent to the relief sought hereunder; IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND DECLARED THAT:

Service

- 1. The time for service of notice of this application is abridged to the time actually given and service of the Notice of Motion and supporting material as described in the Service Affidavit is good and sufficient, and this hearing is properly returnable before this Honourable Court today and further service thereof is hereby dispensed with.
- 2. All capitalized terms not otherwise defined in this Order shall have the meaning ascribed to them in the Initial Order granted in these proceedings on May 26, 2010 (the "Initial Order").

Approval of the 1554670 Financing Agreement

- 3. The financing agreement among 1554670 and the Medican Group, dated September 26, 2010 and attached as Exhibit "A" to the Schneider Affidavit (the "1554670 Financing Agreement") is hereby approved.
- 4. The Medican Group and the Monitor are hereby authorized and directed to do all things reasonably necessary to implement, and perform all of their respective obligations under, the 1554670 Financing Agreement.

Approval of the 1554670 Charge

5. As security for monies advanced by 1554670 to the Medican Group pursuant to the 1554670 Financing Agreement, a charge is hereby granted on all of the undertaking, property and assets of Homes by Kingsland Ltd. used on, in, or in connection with the development project known as Edgewood Brooks Properties in Brooks, Alberta (the "Edgewood Brooks Project") in favour of 1554670 (the "1554670 Charge") ranking in priority to the DIP Lender's Charge, the Administration Charge, and the Directors' Charge.

- 6. The Monitor and the Medican Group are hereby authorized to distribute the Initial Advance, as that term is defined in the 1554670 Financing Agreement, in accordance with the terms of the 1554670 Financing Agreement.
- 7. Upon the distributions described in the foregoing paragraph being made the Monitor shall file a certificate with this Honourable Court confirming that such payments have been made, which certificate, when presented to the Registrar of Land Titles in and for the Province of Alberta (the "Registrar") along with a certified copy of this Order, shall be the sole authority for the Registrar to discharge any encumbrances registered by any party receiving a payment pursuant to paragraph 6 hereof against the Edgewood Brooks Project, notwithstanding section 191(1) of the Land Titles Act (Alberta).

Miscellaneous

- 8. The 1554670 Financing Agreement and the 1554670 Charge shall be valid and enforceable and not be rendered invalid or unenforceable and the rights and remedies of the parties thereto shall not otherwise be limited or impaired in any way by: (i) the pendency of these proceedings and the declaration of insolvency made herein; (ii) any Bankruptcy Order sought or issued pursuant to the *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act* (Canada) (the "BIA") in respect of any of the Medican Group or any assignment in bankruptcy made or deemed to be made in respect of any of the Medican Group; or (iii) any negative covenants, prohibitions or other similar provisions with respect to borrowings, incurring debt or the creation of encumbrances, contained in any existing agreement, lease, sub-lease, offer to lease or other arrangement which binds any of the Medican Group (a "Third Party Agreement"), and notwithstanding any provision to the contrary in any Third Party Agreement:
 - (a) neither the creation of the 1554670 Financing Agreement, the creation of the 1554670 Charge, nor the execution, delivery or performance of the 1554670 Financing Agreement shall create or be deemed to constitute a breach by any of the Medican Group of any Third Party Agreement to which it is a party; and
 - (b) the parties to the 1554670 Financing Agreement shall not have liability to any person whatsoever as a result of any breach of any Third Party Agreement caused

by or resulting from the creation of the 1554670 Charge or the execution, delivery or performance of the 1554670 Financing Agreement.

- 9. Notwithstanding: (i) the pendency of these proceedings and the declaration of insolvency made in these proceedings, (ii) any Bankruptcy Order sought or issued pursuant to the BIA in respect of any of the Applicants or any assignment in bankruptcy made or deemed to be made in respect of any of the Applicants, and (iii) the provisions of any federal or provincial statute, the 1554670 Financing Agreement and the 1554670 Charge shall constitute legal, valid and binding obligations of the Medican Group enforceable against them in accordance with the terms thereof, and the payments made by the parties pursuant to this Order, the 1554670 Financing Agreement, or the 1554670 Charge do not and will not constitute settlements, fraudulent preferences, fraudulent conveyances or other challengeable or reviewable transactions or conduct meriting an oppression remedy under any applicable law, and shall not constitute advances under *The Builders' Liens Act* (Alberta) nor be subject to any builders' lien registered at the date of this Order or thereafter.
- 10. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Order, the rights and remedies of the parties under the 1554670 Financing Agreement shall be subject to the terms of this Order, the Initial Order, including the stay of proceedings, and all other Orders made in these proceedings.
- 11. No action or proceeding may be commenced against a party to the 1554670 Financing Agreement by reason of any such party having entered into the 1554670 Financing Agreement or having performed the obligations thereunder without leave of this Court having been obtained on seven days notice to such party, the Medican Group, and the Monitor.
- 12. The Medican Group, 1554670 and the Monitor or any party to the 1554670 Financing Agreement are at liberty to apply for such further advice, assistance and direction as may be necessary to give full force and effect to the terms of this Order.
- 13. The Medican Group shall serve, by courier, facsimile transmission, e-mail transmission, or ordinary post, a copy of this Order on all parties present at this application and on all parties

who received notice of this application or who are presently on the service list established in these proceedings, and service on any or all other parties is hereby dispensed with. Service effected as aforesaid shall be good and sufficient service.

The Medican Group be and is hereby authorized to extend the DIP credit facility on terms not to exceed: (i) a maturity date of December 31, 2010; and (ii) an extension fee of not greater than 2% payable on maturity, and the Medican Group be and is hereby authorized to do such things as are reasonably necessary to give full effect to such amendments.

Miscellaneous

7.
