ORDER

ON READING the motion (the “**Motion**”) by Minéraux Maudore Inc. for a first extension of the stay of proceedings granted in the initial order of this court dated February 27, 2015 (the “**Initial Order**”) pursuant to the *Companies’ Creditors Arrangement Act*, R.S.C. 1985, c. C-36, as amended (the “**CCAA**”), the cash flow statement and the affidavit of George Fowlie filed in support thereof, the second report of Samson Bélaire / Deloitte & Touche Inc. as monitor (the “**Monitor**”), relying upon the submissions of counsel and being advised that the interested parties, including secured creditors who are likely to be affected by the charges created herein were given prior notice of the presentation of the Motion;

GIVEN the provisions of the CCAA;

WHEREFORE, THE COURT:

1. GRANTS the Motion.
2. DECLARES that all relief granted in the Initial Order in respect of the debtor, including the stay of all proceedings, shall be extended from March 29 to June 14, 2015.
3. ORDERS the provisional execution of the Order notwithstanding any appeal.
