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ENDORSEMENT OF JUSTICE MCEWEN:

Both orders shall go as per the drafts filed and signed. They are unopposed. First, with respect to the Claims Process order, this Court has jurisdiction to grant the order sought. Further, the proposed terms of the order are fair and reasonable. In particular, the Reverse Claims Process is fair and reasonable, and part of a sensible overall hybrid approach. The claims bar date provides a reasonable timeline and the Claims Process will be properly disseminated. Overall, I am satisfied that the provisions of the order further the objectives of the CCAA and should be approved.

Second, the order seeking a declaration that WEPPA applies to former employer copies with the provisions of the CCAA and WEPPA and is consistent with the existing jurisprudence. This motion was brought on notice to the appropriate Federal agency, which provided no comment.
