1.   - (a) all such materials are served on or before Friday, June 21, 2019 on all parties who appear, based upon the records of the Monitor, to have an interest in these proceedings, as more particularly described in the Service List maintained in respect of these proceedings as it exists on that date; or
  - (b) the respondent to be served consents to the jurisdiction of this Honourable Court to consider the application for the Receivership Order notwithstanding that the materials in support thereof were not served upon such respondent at least 14 days prior to the hearing of the application.
