Upon the application by Jeffrey M. Lee, Q.C. and Marek Coutu, counsel on behalf of Deloitle Restructuring Inc. (the "Receiver"), in its capacity as Court-Appointed Receiver of Swift Hotels Group Ltd.   - all such materials are served on or before Thursday, December 12, 2019 at 5:00 p.m. (a) (Saskatchewan time) on all parties who appear, based upon the records of the Receiver, to have an interest in these proceedings, as more particularly described in the Service List maintained in respect of these proceedings as it exists on that date; or
  - the respondents to be served consent to the jurisdiction of this Honourable Court to (b) consider the application for the Order notwithstanding that the materials in support thereof were not served upon such respondents at least 14 days prior to the hearing of the application.
