Part 4: FACTUAL BASIS

- 1. Wedgemount Power Limited Partnership through their general partner, Wedgemount Power (GP) Inc. ("Wedgemount") holds a license of occupation over Crown Land and a water licence.
- 2. Wedgemount has constructed and is in the process of constructing works in and around Wedgemount Creek related to the production of hydro-electric power.

Part 5: LEGAL BASIS

- 1. The Province's concern under the *Land Act* and the *Water Sustainability Act*, is to ensure that the licence holder, including a person exercising those rights, discharges responsibilities as described in the licences and associated legislation in respect of works constructed on the Crown Lands and on Wedgemount Creek, including any decommissioning and remediation of the site if the works are not completed.
- 2. The Province is concerned that these responsibilities will not be properly discharged by the licence holder, or any person exercising those rights, in the manner required by the licences and legislation if works are not completed, and which may result if the application is successful.
