Notice to depositors of the Lutheran Church – Canada, the Alberta – British Columbia District (the "District") who have been receiving payments pursuant to the emergency fund

As you are aware, the Court of Queen's Bench of Alberta (the "Court") granted an Initial order (the "Initial Order") under the *Companies' Creditors Arrangement Act, R.S.C. 1985 c. C-36*, as amended (the "CCAA") in respect of the District on January 23, 2015 (the "Filing Date"). Deloitte Restructuring Inc. acts as the Monitor in the CCAA proceedings (the "Monitor").

An emergency fund was implemented prior to the Filing Date and approved by the Court as part of the Initial Order (the "Emergency Fund"). The District's records indicate that you have been receiving payments pursuant to the Emergency Fund.

On August 2, 2016, the Court granted an Order approving the District's plan of compromise and arrangement (the "District Plan"). The District Plan is currently being implemented and initial cash distributions have been released pursuant to the District Plan. All depositors to the District should have received correspondence in that regard dated between August 12, 2016 and August 16, 2016. As initial cash distributions have been released pursuant to the District Plan, payments pursuant to the Emergency Fund have been discontinued effective immediately.
