



**UPON THE APPLICATION** of Deloitte Restructuring Inc., in its capacity as monitor (in such capacity, the “**Monitor**”) of Lutheran Church – Canada, the Alberta – British Columbia District, Encharis Community Housing and Services, Encharis Management and Support Services, and Lutheran Church – Canada, the Alberta – British Columbia District Investments Ltd. (collectively, the “**Applicants**”) returnable March 3, 2016 for an Order staying and suspending the Alberta Proceeding (defined below) and the BC Proceeding (defined below); **AND UPON HEARING** counsel for the Monitor, counsel for the Applicants, and any other parties present; **AND UPON HAVING READ** the Twelfth Report of the Monitor, filed January 27, 2016, the Fourteenth Report of the Monitor, filed February 24, 2016, the Fifteenth Report of the Monitor, filed February 25, 2016, and the Confidential Supplement thereto, the Affidavit of Randy Kellen, sworn May 15, 2015, the Affidavit of Donald Fraser, sworn August 26, 2015, the Affidavit of Elvira Kroeger, sworn February 23, 2016, the Affidavit of Courtenay Clark, sworn February 23, 2016, the Affidavit of Marilyn Huber, sworn February 24, 2016, the Affidavit of Courtenay Clark, sworn February 26, 2016, the Affidavit of Elvira Kroeger, sworn February 29, 2016, and the Affidavit of Sharon Sherman, sworn March 1, 2016, **AND UPON** the matter being reserved for judgment until March 9, 2016;

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND DECLARED THAT:**

1. All parties entitled to notice of this application have been served with notice of this application and that the time for service is hereby abridged such that service effected on the parties served with notice of this application shall be good and sufficient notice of this application.
2. All capitalized terms not otherwise defined in this Order shall have the meaning ascribed to them in the Initial Order granted by the Honourable Justice K.D. Yamauchi in this Action dated January 23, 2015 (the “**Initial Order**”).
3. The following proceedings are hereby stayed and suspended until applications to sanction the DIL and the District plans of compromise and arrangement (collectively, the “**Plans**”) have been heard and determined by this Court:

- (a) The Court of Queen's Bench of Alberta (Edmonton) proceeding bearing Court File Number 1603-03142 with style of cause *Sharon Sherman and Marilyn Huber v. Lutheran Church – Canada, Lutheran Church – Canada Financial Ministries, Francis Taman, Bishop & McKenzie LLP, John Williams, Roland Chowne, Prowse Chowne LLP, Concentra Trust, and Shepherd's Village Ministries Ltd.* (the "Alberta Proceeding"); and
- (b) The Supreme Court of British Columbia (Vancouver Registry) proceeding bearing Court File Number SE 161737 with style of cause *Elvira Theodora Kroeger and Randall Scott Kellen v. Lutheran Church – Canada, Lutheran Church – Canada Financial Ministries, Francis Taman, Bishop & McKenzie LLP, a Partnership, John Williams, Ronald Chowne, Prowse Chowne LLP, Concentra Trust, and Shepherd's Village Ministries Ltd.* (the "BC Proceeding").
- (c) All proceedings relating to any and all potential claims of DIL Depositors or District Depositors that seek or could seek, directly or indirectly, to recover the amounts of the claims of DIL Depositors or District Depositors, including but not limited to any claims as against any auditors or legal counsel for DIL or District and any derivative claims relating to DIL or District.


