- [8] REESTABLISHES AND EXTENDS the Stay Period (as defined in the Order on a Motion for Recognition of Foreign Proceedings rendered by this Court in this matter on August 5, 2010) retroactively from August 22, 2012 until the earlier of the following dates:
  - (i) November 23, 2012 or:
  - (ii) ten (10) days following the service by Petitioner or the Information Officer to the members of the service list of a notice advising of the new termination date of the conciliation period established by the Mexican Court,

the whole subject to all of the other terms of the Initial Order, as amended and extended;

- [9] DECLARES that the notice of presentation hereof is proper and sufficient;
- [ 10 ] ORDERS that the present order is executory notwithstanding appeal;
