**ORDER FOR EXPEDITED HEARING ON MOTION
OF FOREIGN REPRESENTATIVE FOR *EX PARTE*
PROVISIONAL RELIEF PURSUANT TO SECTIONS
1519, 362, AND 105 OF THE BANKRUPTCY CODE**

This matter is before the Court on the Motion of the Foreign Representative for an Expedited Hearing [Docket no. 7] (the “**Motion for Expedited Hearing**”) on the Motion for *Ex Parte* Provisional Relief Pursuant to Sections 1519, 362 and 105 of the Bankruptcy Code [Docket no. 5] (the “**Motion for *Ex Parte* Provisional Relief**”)¹ filed on January 23, 2012. The Court, having reviewed the Motion for an Expedited Hearing, the Motion for *Ex Parte* Provisional Relief, and the Verified Petitions filed by each of the above-named Foreign Applicants and the entire record in these Chapter 15 Cases, the Court finds that (i) the Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334, (ii) this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2)(P), and (iii) good cause has been shown for the granting of the Motion for Expedited Hearing; and the Court having determined that the factual and legal bases set forth in the Motion establish just cause for the relief granted herein;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The Motion for Expedited Hearing is GRANTED.
2. A hearing shall be held on the Motion for *Ex Parte* Provisional Relief on Wednesday, the 25th day of January, 2012, at 1:30 p.m., in the Courtroom of the
