1. The notice periods for service of this Interim Application (*Inter Partes*) are hereby abridged;
2. Service on the service list set out in Schedule "A" to the Interlocutory Application (*Inter Partes*) is sufficient for the purposes of this Application;
3. The time to file a Proposal in the proceeding is extended commencing from and including the 4th day of April, 2019 to and including May 5, 2019;
4. The Confidential Addendum to the 4th Report of the Proposal Trustee shall remain sealed until the earliest of a Proposal being approved by this Court pursuant to section 58 of the BIA, the Applicants being deemed to have made an assignment in bankruptcy pursuant to any of the provisions of the BIA, or further Order of this Court.
