2. The stay of proceedings is extended commencing from and including the 27th day of May, 2019, to and including July 10, 2019.

The Confidential Addendum to the Report of the Monitor filed herein, together with the affidavit of Anna Graham sworn on May 23, 2019 and Consent Exhibit # 1, shall remain sealed until the earliest of the Applicants becoming bankrupt pursuant to any of the provisions of the BIA, or further Order of this Court.

4. In the event that the Applicants seek a further extension of the stay of proceedings in this matter, the Applicants shall file all materials in support of such an extension by 12:00pm on July 4, 2019. Any materials in response to such an application must be filed by 12:00pm on July 8, 2019.
