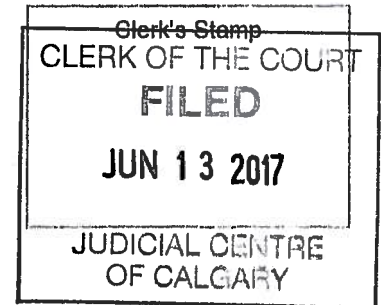

UPON THE APPLICATION OF THE APPLICANTS, The Shepherd of the Valley Lutheran Church (SVLC); AND UPON reviewing the application and supporting Affidavits of the Shepherd of the Valley; AND UPON reviewing the Affidavit in response filed by the Lutheran Church – Canada, Alberta – British Columbia District; AND UPON hearing submissions from counsel for the Applicants, counsel for the District, counsel for the Monitor and counsel for the District Creditor's Committee;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND DECLARED THAT:

1. The Lutheran Church – Canada, Alberta-British Columbia District (the “**District**”) is prohibited from selling or marketing the lands municipally described as 1209 – 1 Avenue, Canmore, Alberta, and legally described as:


PLAN 1095F
BLOCK 92
LOTS 18, 20, 22 AND 24
EXCEPTING THEREOUT ALL MINES AND MINERALS (the “**Lands**”).
2. The agreement between the Shepherd of the Valley Lutheran Church (SVLC) and the District entered into in 1994 regarding the Lands is a valid loan agreement and the District is estopped from denying the right to redeem title to the Lands.
3. The outstanding balance of the loan including interest as at May 2, 2017, is \$280,265.90 plus per diem interest of \$37.31 (the “**Outstanding Loan**”).
4. Upon payment of the Outstanding Loan by the SVLC to the District in full, the District shall immediately take such steps and execute all such deeds, documents, transfers and instruments as may be reasonably necessary to effect the transfer of the title of the Lands from the District to SVLC.
5. This Order may be executed in counterpart and via facsimile or electronic e-mail transmission.


