# NOTICE OF APPLICATION (SLIP RULE)

Names of applicants:

Deloitte Restructuring Inc., in its capacity as the court-appointed receiver and manager (in such capacity, the "Receiver") of the assets, property and undertaking of Otso Gold Corp. (the "Debtor")

TAKE NOTICE that an application will be made by the Receiver to the presiding judge or master at the courthouse at 800 Smithe Street, Vancouver, British Columbia, V6Z 2E1 on April 14, 2022 at 9:45a.m.. for the order set out in Part 1 below.

### Part 1: ORDERS SOUGHT

- 1. An order in substantially in the form attached as **Schedule** "A" which amends the order made and entered April 12, 2022 (the "**Vesting Order**") to add, at Schedule D, a document which was omitted when the Vesting Order was entered.
- 2. Such further and other orders, declarations, and directions as counsel may request and this Honourable Court deems to be just and convenient in the circumstances.

### **Part 2: FACTUAL BASIS**

- 3. On April 12, 2022, Mr. Justice Gomery granted the Vesting Order which approved a transaction for the Receiver to sell certain mineral claims and made directions to implement the transaction, including directions regarding changes in title to mineral claims listed at Schedule D to the Vesting Order.
- 4. The version of the Vesting Order that was entered with the Court, inadvertently, did not include the schedule of mineral claims at Schedule D, although the Schedule references an attached table.
- 5. The Receiver seeks an order amending the Vesting Order to insert the mineral claims table at Schedule D.
- 6. All parties affected by the relief sought and appearing on the application have consented to this correction of the error arising from the omission.
- 7. The Receiver seeks the correction on an urgent basis to facilitate closing of the transaction contemplated by the Vesting Order and to ensure fulfillment of the conditions of the transaction documents approved by the Vesting Order.

### **Part 3: LEGAL BASIS**

- 8. The Receiver relies upon the Supreme Court Civil Rules, including Rule 8-1 and 13-1(17) and the inherent jurisdiction of this Honourable Court.
- 9. Pursuant to Rule 13-1(17) of the *Supreme Court Civil Rules*, this Honourable Court may, at any time, correct an error arising from an accidental slip or omission. The Receiver requests the correction of the Vesting Order to insert the mineral claims at Schedule D, which were accidentally omitted from the version submitted for entry, to ensure the result intended by the Court in granting the Vesting Order.
