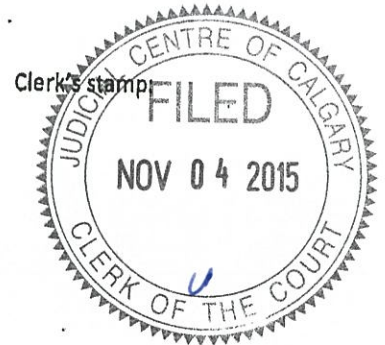



UPON the application of Ernst & Young Inc., in its capacity as receiver manager (the "Receiver") of Kyoto Fuels Corporation ("KFC") in these proceedings; AND UPON having read the Order of this Honourable Court, dated May 12, 2015, approving of the sale and vesting of certain assets of KFC (the "Sale Order"); AND UPON noting the Sale Order directed the Receiver to make a holdback from the net proceeds of sale as a Claims Reserve, pending further Order of this Honourable Court; AND UPON noting the consent of Thermo Fisher Financial Services Inc. ("Thermo Fisher"), CP Energy Marketing LP ("CP"), Agriculture Financial Services Corporation ("AFSC"), and the Receiver, endorsed hereon; AND UPON hearing submissions from counsel for the Receiver;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND DECLARED THAT:


1. All capitalized terms not otherwise defined herein shall have the meaning ascribed to them in the Sale Order.
2. The Receiver is hereby authorized and directed to:
  - A. pay \$57,500.00 from the Claims Reserve to Thermo Fisher in full and final satisfaction of the TF Claim against the Claims Reserve (the "TF Settlement Payment"); and
  - B. release the remaining amount of the Claims Reserve to the Receiver to be distributed upon the consent of the Receiver as a part of the KFC estate free and clear of the TF Claim.
3. Following receipt by Thermo Fisher of the TF Settlement Payment, all Claims of Thermo Fisher, including the TF Claim, against the Claims Reserve and the other sale proceeds of KFC assets sold by the Receiver as approved in the Sale Order, shall be and hereby are deemed to be fully and finally satisfied and discharged.
4. This Order may be executed in separate counterparts by facsimile or electronic transmission.






