Return of Equipment

1. With respect to Central Island Excavating Ltd. ("**CIE**"), the relief set out at paragraph 1(b) of the Monitor's Notice of Application filed February 18, 2025, with respect to the return of the 2014 Hitachi 370 Forester Log Loader, model ZX37OF-3 with serial number FFBHJOXPC0370028 (the "Log Loader") is adjourned to February 27, 2025 (the "Adjourned Hearing").

2. CIE shall advise the Monitor of the location of the Log Loader by 4:00 pm on February 25, 2025.

3. CIE shall advise the Monitor of any change in location of the Log Loader forthwith after any such change in location.

4. Until the hearing of the Adjourned Application, CIE shall not sell, encumber, or transfer the Log Loader.

5. CIE may apply to vary this Order on 48 hours' notice, with such notice being provided to the Monitor and other parties listed on the service list maintained in these *Companies' Creditors Arrangement Act* ("**CCAA**") proceedings, in the manner provided for by the CCAA service list.

6. A copy of this Order is to be sent to CIE by the Monitor forthwith.

General

7. Endorsement of this Order by counsel appearing on this application other than counsel for the Monitor is hereby dispensed with.

THIS COURT REQUESTS the aid and recognition of other Canadian and foreign courts, tribunal, regulatory or administrative bodies, including any Court or administrative tribunal or any federal or State Court or administrative body in the United States of America, to act in aid of and to be complementary to this Court in carrying out the terms of this Order where required. All courts, tribunals, regulatory and administrative bodies are hereby respectfully requested to make such orders and provide such assistance to the Petitioners and to the Monitor, as an officer of this Court, as may be necessary or desirable to give effect to this Order, to grant the Monitor representative status in any foreign proceeding, or to assist the Petitioners and the Monitor and their respective agents in carrying out the terms of this Order.
