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ON THE APPLICATION OF Royal Bank of Canada ("RBC", or, the "Bank"), coming on for hearing at Vancouver, British Columbia, on this day, AND ON HEARING Glen Nesbitt, counsel for the Bank, and those other persons listed on <u>Schedule "B</u>" hereto; AND UPON READING the materials filed, including the Affidavit #1 of a Special Loans Director of the Bank made February 3, 2025, the Fourth Report of the Monitor dated February 3, 2025, and the Fifth Report of the Monitor dated February 18, 2025;

### THIS COURT ORDERS that:

- 1. The Bank's application brought under the Notice of Application filed February 3, 2025, in these proceedings is adjourned and reset for hearing on March 4, 2025 (the "Hearing Date"), at 6 0. m., for before Justice Stephens, on the following terms and conditions:
  - (a) from February 4, 2025, to the Hearing Date, the Kingsley Group shall:

- (i) deposit any funds obtained from any source in the ordinary course of business to the Kingsley Group's accounts held with RBC;
- (ii) operate only in the ordinary course of business, and not dispose of any of its assets outside of the ordinary course of business; and
- (iii) permit Deloitte Restructuring Inc., the court-appointed monitor of the Petitioners (in such capacity, the "Monitor"), to have access to the Kingsley Group's physical assets and property in order to take an inventory of the same; and
- (b) from the date of this Order to the Hearing Date, the Kingsley Group, and its employees, consultants, agents, representatives, and advisors shall: (i) cooperate fully with the Monitor and any requests for information that it may make pursuant to this Order; and (ii) provide such assistance as the Monitor may reasonably request from time to time to enable the Monitor to take an inventory of the Kingsley Group's physical assets and property.
- 2. The Kingsley Group, and any other party to these proceedings, shall have liberty to apply to this Court for directions with respect to the terms of this Order on 48 hours' notice to the Kingsley Group and those parties listed on the Service List maintained by the Monitor in these proceedings.

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3. Endorsement of this Order by counsel appearing, other than counsel for the Bank, is hereby dispensed with.
