Take notice that on January 24, 2025, an Order in respect of the Debtors was granted by the Ontario Superior Court of Justice (Commercial List) (the "**Court**") pursuant to the *Companies' Creditors Arrangement Act*, R.S.C. 1985, c. C-36, as amended (the "**CCAA**").

Deloitte Restructuring Inc. has been appointed as monitor in the Debtors' CCAA proceedings (the "**Monitor**") pursuant to the Initial Order of the Court dated January 24, 2025 (the "**Initial Order**").

Copies of the Initial Order and the materials related to the Court application have been posted on the Monitor's website at: <http://www.insolvencies.deloitte.ca/tncc> (the "**Website**").

The Initial Order provides, among other things, for a stay of proceedings until February 3, 2025 (the "**Stay Period**") in respect of the Debtors. The Debtors have advised the Court that they will be seeking an extension of the Stay Period, among other relief, on or about February 3, 2025. Additional details can be found on the Website.

During the Stay Period, all parties are prohibited from commencing or continuing legal or enforcement actions against the Debtors and all rights and remedies of any party against or in respect of the Debtors or their assets are stayed and suspended except with the written consent of the Debtors and the Monitor, or leave of the Court.

Creditors are not required to file a proof of claim at this time.
