## Remedy claimed or sought:

- 1. The applicant, Canadian Exotic Grains Ltd., seeks an order:
  - (a) validating service of this notice of application and supporting materials;

- (b) extending the stay of proceedings and the period within which CEG is required to file a proposal to its creditors with the Official Receiver from September 28, 2018 to 11:59 p.m. on November 12, 2018; and
- (c) such further and other relief as CEG may request and this Honourable Court may allow.

## Grounds for making this application:

- 2. On August 8, 2018, CEG applied for and was granted a Sale Approval, Vesting, and Extension Order (the "SAVO"), approving, among other things, a sale of substantially all of CEG's business assets to an entity called Section 12 (the "Transaction").
- 3. Since the issuance of the SAVO, CEG has worked in good faith and with due diligence to close the Transaction; however, the purchaser subsequently confirmed that it is unable to close the same.
- 4. With the deadline for CEG to file a proposal approaching on September 28, 2019, CEG requires an extension to provide CEG additional time to:
  - (a) determine whether some iteration of the Transaction can be salvaged; or
  - (b) alternatively, explore all other available options to maximize the realizable value of its assets.
