Appendix A - Amended Proposed Distribution Schedule

## PURPOSE

1. The purpose of this supplemental report dated March 3, 2021 (the "Supplemental Report") is to provide the Court with an amended proposed distribution schedule (the "Amended Proposed Distribution Schedule") in the Composites Innovation Centre Manitoba Inc. ("CIC") proposal proceedings. The Proposed Distribution Schedule attached as Appendix D to the February 26, 2021 Trustee's Report inadvertently omitted the full payment of the Floor Creditors' Claims as defined in paragraph 3.2(d)(i) of the May 26, 2020 Proposal (the "Proposal").
2. Paragraph 3.2(d) of the Proposal details the following:
d) Ordinary Unsecured Claims: Ordinary Unsecured Creditors who are the holders of Proven Unsecured Claims ("Proven Ordinary Unsecured Claims"), will receive, from the Basket Amount, after payment of the Professional Fees, Crown Claims, and, Preferred Claims, the following amounts, as agreed by the Proposal Trustee or finally determined for distribution purposes in accordance with the provisions of the BIA or any applicable orders from the Court:
i. Firstly, each Ordinary Unsecured Creditor who holds a Proven Unsecured Claim equal to or less than $\$ 2,000.00$, including those Ordinary Unsecured Creditors that choose to reduce their Proven Ordinary Unsecured claim to \$2,000.00 (collectively "Floor Creditors' Claims") shall be entitled to receive a dividend equal to the lesser of $\$ 2,000.00$ and the aggregate amount of such Creditor's Proven Ordinary Unsecured Claim;
ii. Secondly, each Ordinary Unsecured Creditor who holds a Proven Ordinary Unsecured Claim in an aggregate amount in excess of \$2,000.00 (and who has not chosen to reduce its Proven Ordinary Unsecured Claim to $\$ 2,000.00)$, shall be entitled to receive a dividend equal to its pro-rata share of measured in relation to all Proven Ordinary Unsecured Claims, from the available Basket Amount of funds; and
iii. All dividends paid are subject to the Superintendent's Levy payable in respect thereof as required by the BIA.
3. The Amended Proposed Distribution Schedule accounts for payment of the Floor Creditors' Claims in full, which has resulted in a reallocation of $\$ 903.03$ from the previously proposed distributions to the Proven Ordinary Unsecured Creditors.
4. In accordance with section 152(2) of the Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act, the Trustee's Final Statement of Receipts and Disbursements and the Amended Proposed Distribution Schedule have been approved by the estate inspectors.
