ENDORSEMENT OF Mr Justice MCEWEN:

Order to go as per the draft filed & signed. The motion is unopposed. The extension of the stay is justified in the circumstances of this case given the further steps that are necessary.

The Kestutis Settlement Agreement is fair and reasonable. It is also sensible to release the funds as suggested. I agree that it is sensible to release these "de minimis" funds to UAFA given their size, and expense necessary to continue to have them processed by third parties.

The Eleventh Report is approved as are the fees which are reasonable.

Last, the sealing order shall go as the Sienna Club criteria, as recast in Sherma Estate, have been met. Little has been redacted and it involves cash flows (which ought to remain confidential given ongoing litigation) and the Kestutis settlement (which is not yet finalized).
