ENDORSEMENT OF JUSTICE KIMMEL:

- [1] By letter dated July 15, 2026 addressed to me in my capacity as the Team Lead of the Commercial List in Toronto and addressed to Justice Michael Bordin, Local Administrative Judge Central South Region (Hamilton Bankruptcy Court), sent pursuant to an earlier direction of Osborne J. dated November 11, 2025, the Trustee is seeking a case conference/scheduling appointment to consider its request to transfer

this proceeding to the Commercial List in Toronto and to schedule a motion for approval of a proposed claims process to address the claims of up to 200 former students of the bankrupt educational facility, which variously allege physical, mental and sexual abuse for which the bankrupt may be liable.

- [2] In consultation with Justice Bordin, I requested that counsel for the Trustee appear *ex parte* before me today so that I could understand the history of this matter before considering the request to schedule a case conference on the Commercial List. Counsel for the Trustee having appeared today, I am prepared to schedule a case conference for the interested stakeholders to appear (in person or through their counsel) at which the court will consider:
- a. The Trustee's request to transfer this Bankruptcy Proceeding to the Commercial List in Toronto; and
 - b. If the transfer request is granted, to schedule the Trustee's proposed Claims Process approval motion and set a timetable for the pre-hearing steps.
- [3] The court is able to offer either September 15 or 17, 2026 at 12:00 noon for a one-hour case conference. Counsel for the Trustee shall provide a copy of this endorsement forthwith to all interested stakeholders (or their counsel) and canvass availability for one of these dates for the case conference, and then confirm that date with the Commercial List Scheduling Office so that the other date can be released.
- [4] In advance of the scheduled case conference, counsel for the Trustee shall communicate with participating stakeholders (or their counsel) about the proposed transfer of this matter to the Commercial List in Toronto and about a proposed timetable for this Claims Process approval motion and deliver an Aide Memoire (maximum 3 pages double spaced) at least two days prior to the scheduled case conference date that sets out what is proposed, what is agreed and what is not agreed. Any participating stakeholder who has not agreed to what the Trustee is proposing prior to that same filing deadline shall deliver their own Aide Memoire (maximum 3 pages double spaced) setting out their points of disagreement and the basis for them.
- [5] Since there is no Toronto court file for this matter, all of the materials for this case conference shall be served by email and then forwarded by email (bookmarked PDF's attached) to the Commercial List Office (JUS-G-MAG-CSD-Toronto-SCJ Commercial List MAG.CSD.To.SCJCom@ontario.ca) requesting that they be forwarded to the attention of the judge presiding at the case conference by no later than 4:30 p.m. two days prior to the case conference date.
