



UPON the application (the "Application") of the Royal Bank of Canada (the "Bank"), in respect of Surface Pro Services Inc. ("SPS"), Atkins Kuntz Construction Group Inc. ("AKC") and 2049829 Alberta Inc. ("204") (SPS, AKC and 204 are collectively referred to herein as the "Debtor") to appoint Deloitte Restructuring Inc. as interim receiver of the Debtor; AND UPON having read the Application, the Affidavit of Josh Coonan, sworn on March 12, 2019, the Supplemental Affidavit of Josh Coonan sworn on March 15, 2019, the Affidavit of Stella Kim sworn on March 15, 2019 and the Affidavit of Doug Atkins sworn on March 15, 2019; AND UPON hearing counsel for the Bank and representatives of the Debtor;

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND DECLARED THAT:**

1. The Application is hereby adjourned to 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, March 19, 2019.
2. No later than close of business on Monday, March 18, 2019, the Debtor shall provide the Bank with proof that all remittances have been paid to the Canada Revenue Agency to date for each of SPS and AKC in respect of source deductions and G.S.T.
3. As soon as reasonably practicable, SPS and AKC shall provide to the Bank:
  - (a) the list of cheques which SPS and AKC advise they are holding to satisfy employee payroll;
  - (b) the list of employees and employee cheques which SPS and AKC indicates it is preparing to satisfy employee payroll for March 15, 2019 and any employee payroll that has not been paid for March 1, 2019 (collectively, "Payroll").
4. In the event SPS and AKC provide the Bank with certified funds to satisfy Payroll, the Bank shall authorize the release of the employee cheques referenced in paragraph 3(b) of this Order, to satisfy Payroll.
5. Rule 9.4(2)(c) is hereby invoked and approval of this form of order by the Debtor is not required.
