### AFFIDAVIT OF JOSH COONAN

Sworn on March 19, 2019

I, Josh Coonan, of Calgary, Alberta, SWEAR AND SAY THAT:

 I am a manager of Special Loans and Advisory Services for the Plaintiff, the Royal Bank of Canada ("RBC" or the "Bank"), and am presently responsible for the administration of the within accounts. As such, I have personal knowledge of the matters and facts hereinafter sworn to, except where stated to be based on information and belief, and where so stated, I verily believe the same to be true.

- I make this Affidavit as a supplement to the affidavits I swore in these proceedings on March 12, 2019 and March 15, 2019 (together, the "Prior Affidavits"). Capitalized terms not defined herein have the meaning ascribed to them in the Prior Affidavits.
- 3. Subsequent to the Bank's appearance before the Court on March 15, 2019:
  - (a) On Friday, March 15, 2019, I received an email from Dave Renton of SPS attaching a scanned image of the cheques for deposit (the "Deposit Cheques") into the SPS and AKC accounts intended to satisfy payroll. Attached hereto and marked as Exhibit "A" is a copy of the email from Mr. Renton attaching the cheque images for the Deposit Cheques.
  - (b) On Friday, March 15, 2019, I replied to Mr. Renton advising that of the eight Deposit Cheques provided, only two needed to be certified. Attached hereto and marked as Exhibit "B" is my response email to Mr. Renton. Attached hereto and marked as Exhibit "C" is a spreadsheet I prepared summarizing the Deposit Cheques and identifying which of them required certification.
  - (c) Shortly after sending my reply to Mr. Renton at Exhibit "B", I spoke to him over the phone at which time, Mr. Renton advised that the funds could not be certified as they had already been deposited into the account. I indicated to Mr. Renton that I would have to think about whether I could let the cheques go but that if SPS or AKC made a deposit of certified funds to cover the difference, the Bank would consider the amounts for payroll covered. On Monday, I confirmed to Mr. Renton that the Bank could not consider the cheques clear given that they were not certified and that we would have to wait for back office at the Bank to advise if they were clear.
  - (d) As far as I understand, no additional funds, certified or otherwise, were deposited into the SPS or AKC accounts on Monday, other than an EFT payment made in the amount of \$10,759.51 which was insufficient to cover the shortfall from the uncertified cheques.
  - (e) Later on during the evening of March 15, 2019, I received a payroll cheque list for SPS and AKC from Charli Atkins. Attached hereto and marked as **Exhibit "D"** is a copy of

the email from Mr. Atkins together with the excel spreadsheets attached to Mr. Atkins' email purporting to list the payroll cheques. The cheques listed for AKC total \$31,698.85 and for SPS total \$57,892.63, for a total of \$89,591.48.

- (f) The following day, on March 16, 2019 I replied to Mr. Atkins' email indicating that the Bank required the names of the employees, gross pay, net pay and cheque numbers so that the Bank could confirm the cheques were properly being cleared for payroll. A copy of my response to Mr. Atkins is attached hereto as Exhibit "E".
- (g) A clarification email was sent to me on March 16, 2019 by Mr. Renton advising that the payroll included employee banked hours and expenses. Attached hereto and marked as Exhibit "F" is a copy of the response from Mr. Renton.
- (h) I understand based on emails from the borrower that cheques were issued to employees on March 16, 2019. I am advised by one of the branch managers at RBC that one of the employees attended at an RBC branch to cash their cheque. The branch reviewed the borrower's account and noted that all of the credit facilities were over limit. The manager at the branch contacted me by telephone to confirm whether or not the cheque could be cashed. I had all of my calls forwarded to my cell phone on the weekend to ensure that I could address any potential issues on this file over the weekend. Unfortunately, however, I was unavailable when the manager made the call. I returned the original call to the manager minutes after the message was left, but it took approximately one hour and 45 minutes for the branch manager and I to connect and resolve the issue. Ultimately, the issue was resolved and a message was placed on the accounts to avoid any confusion in the future, instructing all branch staff to cash any payroll cheques issued on March 15, 2019, as authorized by the Court.
- On March 18, 2019, I received an email from John Cameron attaching printouts in relation to the employee cheques issued by SPS and AKC. After reviewing this information, I had a number of questions which I posed to Mr. Cameron via email, relating to what appeared to be inconsistencies in the payroll register and duplicate cheques issued to employees. Mr. Renton replied to my emails, advising that the duplicate cheques related to regular payroll, banked hours and in some cases, reimbursement of expenses incurred by the employees. Mr. Renton also advised of some anomalies in relation to the employee of another entity

paid out of SPS. Attached hereto and marked as **Exhibit "G"** are copies of the correspondence chain between Mr. Cameron, myself and Mr. Renton.

- (j) On March 18, 2019, I was copied to an email from Mr. Cameron providing some information in relation to SPS and AKC's CRA status. Attached hereto and marked as **Exhibit "H"** is a copy of the correspondence from Mr. Cameron, together with the attachments thereto in respect of the CRA status. Based on my calculations, there appears to be no less than \$155,000 in unpaid priority payables to the CRA, approximately \$154,000 of which relates to employee source deductions.
- 4. I have pulled updated Account Information sheets from RBC's system, summarizing each of SPS and AKC's accounts as of March 18, 2019 as follows:
  - (a) Attached hereto and marked as **Exhibit "I"** to this my Affidavit, is the Account Information for the SPS accounts as of March 18, 2019 which shows:
    - (i) After depositing the Deposit Cheques, SPS has a balance of \$70,099.63 in its chequing account;
    - (ii) The credit card account continues to have a balance of \$140,995.01 (limit is \$100,000);
    - (iii) Interest on the revolving line has continued to accrue with a balance of \$235,434.58 (limit is \$250,000); and
    - (iv) Similarly, interest on the demand loan has continued to accrue, with a balance of \$1,719.97.
  - (b) Attached hereto and marked as Exhibit "J" to this my Affidavit, is the Account Information for the AKC accounts as of March 14, 2019 as follows:
    - (i) After depositing the Deposit Cheques, the chequing account is in overdraft by \$1,033.23;
    - (ii) The Credit Card account balances remain over their limits at \$26,227.99 and \$26,256.36, respectively (limit is \$25,000 each);
    - (iii) Interest on the revolving line has continued to accrue, with a balance of \$459,309.28.52 (limit is \$350,000).
- 5. While the RBC indebtedness continues to increase beyond authorized limits, AKC and SPS have allowed RBC's security to be significantly eroded by failing to pay any CRA source deductions for

the 2019 period. Neither company has offered any solution to this increasingly prejudicial position nor has it convinced RBC that there is any alternative to the appointment of a Receiver.

6. Given that the ten day period has expired under the notices of intention to enforce security, RBC will now be asking the Court to appoint a full-fledged receiver over SPS, AKC and 204. I make this affidavit in support of RBC's application in these proceedings and for no improper purpose.

I have made notes next to the highlighted items in your spreadsheet. Some employees have multiple checks because they had regular payroll plus banked hours that were owed to them. Some have expense checks. Those are when an employee pays for something for the company, we reimburse them at the next payroll.

Adam Kuntz normally gets his paycheck through Heartwood Tree Care. SPS would normally transfer money from the SPS account into Heartwood to cover the check. As we were not able to do that this time, we created Adam's check in Heartwood as per usual so all source deductions and income are captured properly, once we did that we wrote a check directly to Adam out of SPS. An inter-company entry is made in SPS and Heartwood so that the money can be reconciled when Heartwood has more money to pay SPS back.

A few employees are set up under a numbered company, but they receive payroll every two weeks the same as everyone else.

The auto-debit amounts that you saw were lease payments, we are working with our leasing companies regarding those amounts, They are not payroll items.
