NOTE: If an affidavit or solemn declaration is attached, it must have been made before a person qualified to take affidavits or solemn declarations.

WARNINGS: A trustee may, pursuant to subsection 128(3) of the Act, redeem a security on payment to the secured creditor of the debt or the value of the security as assessed, in a proof of security, by the secured creditor.

 - Ticking (B) - Indicates your claim is secured and you must insert the value at which you assess your security. Details of each item of security you hold should be attached as a separate schedule and submitted with a copy of your registered security interest.
 - Ticking (C) - Indicates your claim as a farmer, fisherman or aquaculturist.
 - Ticking (D) - Indicates your claim against a director. *Applies only in the case of a proposal, not a bankruptcy.*

General Proxy

If it is desired to appoint a proxy, the proxy form must be completed and signed by the **creditor**; if the creditor is a corporation, the proxy form **must be signed in the corporate name** and not necessarily by the individual signing the proof of claim form, and it **must be witnessed.** You may not appoint a corporation as a proxy.
