UPON THE APPLICATION of Lutheran Church - Canada, the Alberta - British Columbia District (the "District"), EnCharis Community Housing and Services ("ECHS"), EnCharis Management and Support Services, and Lutheran Church - Canada, the Alberta - British Columbia District Investments Ltd. (collectively the "Applicants"); **AND UPON** having read the Affidavit of Cameron Sherban sworn June 30, 2017; **AND UPON NOTING** the consent of counsel for the Applicants, Lutheran Church - Canada ("LCC"), the Monitor, and the

District Creditors' Committee hereon; AND UPON HEARING counsel for the Applicants, counsel for the Monitor, counsel for the District Creditors' Committee, and other interested parties;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND DECLARED THAT:

- 1. LCC's claim shall be allowed at \$703,941.58 as an unsecured creditor of the District (the "LCC District Claim").
- 2. In full and final settlement of the LCC District Claim, LCC shall:
 - (a) receive without set-off, deduction or counterclaim the amount of \$164,000 on account of the Convenience Payment, as that term is defined in the District Plan and its pro-rata share of all other cash distributions under the District Plan; and
 - (b) not receive any shares in NewCo, as that term is defined in the District Plan, under the District Plan (the "NewCo Shares").
- 3. The 400,373 NewCo Shares held by the District in trust, pending the resolution of the LCC District Claim, shall be administered as follows
 - a. 2,595 Newco Shares shall be transferred to Lutheran Women's Missionary League Canada/ABC District in partial payment of its claim under the District Plan;
 - b. the remaining 397,778 Newco Shares shall be cancelled effective as of the date hereof and each of the Applicants; and

c. the District, the Monitor and NewCo are authorized to do all such other acts and to execute all such documents and instruments necessary or advisable to give effect to such transfer and cancellation.
