Hi Allan,

In my conversations this morning with Herman Briese he spoke of the following:

He was aware that emergency funding was available but he did not apply for it because he has always had enough to eat. Herta has put up enough canning that they still, even today, have enough to eat. They have the very basics of food, shelter and clothing. He came to this country and has worked very hard to save up money for his retirement. They have always put in a garden and have had enough to eat. Today it is snowing again, and the garden area from which he cleared snow is white again, so he will have to wait a little longer before he can put in this year's garden.

He is shocked to think that they (those who oppose the lifting of the Stay) suggest that he and Herta are not in need of their money. He said that he worked very hard his entire life to save up for his retirement. Nobody gave him any money. He and Herta worked hard for all of it. Because of their simple setting, they were able to live on the interest that they were receiving from their CEF deposits. With Herta's needs, it has become a strain on their living without access to the money that they had saved. Because of Herta's stroke, she now needs expensive pills to help her condition. These high medical expenses add a financial strain to their existing strain of not having access to their savings. Herman told me that Herta can not do the cleaning and laundry and other things that she used to be able to do. He said that moving to a senior's home is needed, but their costs would then be way higher. He said that he needs access to what he had saved up.
