

## ORDER

ON READING the motion by the Debtor, Minéraux Maudore Inc., for a third extension of the stay of proceedings granted in the initial order of this court dated February 27, 2015 (the “**Initial Order**”) pursuant to the *Companies’ Creditors Arrangement Act*, R.S.C. 1985, c. C-36, as amended, and the affidavit of George Fowlie filed in support thereof; the second report of Deloitte Restructuring Inc. as monitor (the “**Monitor**”), including the debtor’s cash flow forecast until February 28, 2016; relying upon the submissions of counsel and the Monitor, and being advised that the interested parties were given prior notice of the presentation of the motion;


GIVEN the provisions of the CCAA;

**WHEREFORE, THE COURT:**

1. GRANTS the motion;
2. DECLARES that all relief granted in the Initial Order in respect of the Debtor, including the stay of all proceedings, is extended until February 29, 2016;
3. ORDERS the provisional execution of the order notwithstanding any appeal.
